Conditions of Employment

The FWS Program offers no sickwie, compensatory time, vacation, overtimeholiday pay. As stated previously, students are employed under "an hour's pay for an hour's work" arrangement. A student's FWS award may allowhim or her to work upto 15 hours per week. If the student is working hours to make missed from workhe/she may not workmore than 20 hours per week or 7.5 hours per day. All work must supervised. Students should not be allowed to work when regular Heriford weeks are not at work from FWS

- x Students must not be allowed to work during scheduled class hours.
- x Students must not be allowed to workome than 7.5 hours per day or thours a week during enrollment period a student should only bellowed to work 20 hours to make up hours missed in a previous work week).

- x Students must not be allowed to work more hours per semester than their-wortoutky award will pay.
